

Admissions Policy for Career, Vocational, and Technical Education

All students in good standing are eligible to participate in any Chapter 74 approved, Career, Vocational, and Technical Education (CVTE) program at Gloucester High school. Any student who wishes to enroll in a CVTE program should meet with their guidance counselor and request a course selection for the desired program. Placement will be determined by year of graduation and experience in the field of study. All students who apply will be accepted on a space available basis. A waiting list denoting the students' names and the number of seats available in each program will be maintained in guidance.
